font-family: "Times", Serif
font-style: italic
font-weight: bold
text-decoration: none; (underline,
    overline, line-through)
text-transformation: uppercase
font-variant: small-caps
overflow: hidden
```

Background:

```
background-color: black;
background-image: url("bkg.jpg")
background-repeat: repeat-x
background-position: right top
background: white url("bkg.jpeg") top
```

Tables and divs:

```
Border-style: solid
border-width: 1px
border: 1px solid black
border-collapse: collapse
padding: 6px
width: 90%
height: 50pt
vertical-align: top
```
