Scenario for the whole quiz: you are tasked with writing a website for a human resources department.

- 1. [5 points] Create a file named personnel.xml. This file should contain data for three potential employees.
  - (a) Use the names of *five* characters from your second favorite movie of all time.
  - (b) Each potential employee should have two fields: a name and another field of your choice (something numeric).
- 2. [10 points] Write a file named personnel.inc. This is a PHP include file for processing the personnel file.
  - (a) Write a function named names() which return an array of the names of the employees.
  - (b) Write a function named sortedNames() which returns an array of the names of the employees, sorted. (The names can be a single field, and you can assume that people enter the names "Last, First".)
  - (c) Write a function named sortedNamesSQL() which returns an array of the names of the employees, sorted. This time, assume the data comes from a database in personnel.db from a table named potentials with a field named name.
- 3. [5 points] Write a file names list.php. In this file, generate an XHTML document that contains an *unordered* list of the *sorted* names of potential employees.
